The neighborhood has plan that details community level wildfire risk reduction projects and recommends general actions that should be taken by property owners and residents. A team of residents volunteers for your neighborhood through the non-profit organization FireWise of Southwest Colorado and receives ongoing training and support from experts through this local wildfire preparedness organization. The volunteers will plan work days and seek funds to perform forest thinning and defensible space projects in the community. All work shall be conducted according to best forest management practices and with specifications by the property owner and funding sources.

AMBASSADOR TEAM RESPONSIBILITIES

- Conduct project oversight
- Record volunteer hours for matching contribution credit and national recognition status
- Survey and mark project boundaries with neon green flagging
- Conduct photographic documentation before, during, and after completion

PROPERTY OWNER RESPONSIBILITIES

- Mark all wildlife trees, special trees, or other features that you wish to be avoided during the treatment on your property with neon pink flagging tape
- Participate in neighborhood work days in your project area and other project areas as feasible and track volunteer time for planning or performing fuels reduction
- Agree on contractor work specifications
- Advise contractor of any requirements regarding the work schedule
- Ensure that access is available for the contractor
- Agree to community's use of the project photographs, their reproduction, and dissemination for fire related purposes
